Youth Development Partnership Fund

The Youth Development Partnership Fund (YDPF) enables the Ministry of Youth Development and Territorial Authorities to support services for young people aged 12 to 24, to develop skills, knowledge and experience to participate confidently in their communities.

What is the criteria?

Projects need to:

- demonstrate **Youth Community Leadership** - Projects which assist young people to establish local connections, improve confidence, develop and practice leadership skills, allowing them to positively contribute and influence their community

And/or

- demonstrate **Youth Volunteering** – Projects and activities that encourage and support young people to participate more in their community through volunteering including young people encouraging and supporting other young people to get involved

And/or

- demonstrate **Celebration of Youth Achievement** - Projects which assist young people to showcase themselves and their peers, through youth run events, activities and initiatives
- benefit young people aged 12 to 24 years old
- be completed within the funding year.

What are the expected outcomes?

It is expected that:

- young people have the skills to influence/make decisions
- young people participate in decision making opportunities at a local and national level
- young people participate in leadership roles
- young people lead community events and activities
- young people participate in voluntary activity.
